#### WHAT IS THE ENERGY-OPS SECURITY AGORA INITIATIVE?



#### **Our Format (Under Chatham House rules)**


5-6 x 45-minute interactive sessions per day Structured strictly for time keeping - 15-minute Use Case Overview from moderator, 30-minutes community debate


